CERTIFICATION DECISIONS

Upon review of the auditor's report and recommendation, the NBAC will make a determination of certification. The determination will be accomplished by a vote of the commission, with each commissioner having one vote. A majority of the commissioners must vote affirmatively on the certification request for certification to be granted. If certification is not granted, the basis for the denial, identifying all material deficiencies, will be sent to the applicant in writing.

APPEAL OF ADVERSE DECISIONS

An applicant who is denied certification has thirty days in which to submit a written appeal of an adverse decision. The appeal must identify the elements of the audit report, which are believed to be inaccurate or otherwise erroneous.
